# What to expect from a visit to Crocodiles of the World

### We are the UK's only crocodile and alligator zoo.

Your students will have the largest collection of crocodiles and alligators in the UK as their classroom for the day.

There is a full range of talks and feeding sessions, with crocodiles as well as our other animals, including meerkats, otters, and birds.

Our Education Room seats 60 students, with giant smart screen, museum specimens, and space to store bags and coats whilst the children walk about the zoo.

A hands-on session featuring live reptiles will not only thrill the students, but will keep them engaged and help make the learning come to life!

There is ample space for lunch.

Our Croc Café will cater for the adults that need a coffee, tea or full meal.

## What to bring on your visit

We need to keep our crocodiles warm. As a result, our buildings are maintained at tropical temperatures.

#### They can be quite warm, or hot.

So, it is best to wear layers that can be taken off when we go inside, especially on cooler days. Students should drink plenty of water, especially on hot days.

Lunch: bring your own, or pre-order lunch packs.

Café: there is a full menu available at our Croc Café: hot & cold drinks, ice creams and snacks, or full freshly cooked meals.

Weather: most of our exhibits are indoors, so rain is only a problem when moving between buildings, and with a few of the mammal exhibits.

If the students will be writing or drawing, please bring clipboards, pens and pencils.

## Bring the classroom alive with crocodiles, alligators or snakes!

An outreach visit gives the students the thrill of seeing these amazing animals up close in a hands-on presentation that will reinforce class learning.

In general, each presentation lasts for one hour\*. Recommended class sizes are between 30-60.

As with the zoo visits, we will work with you to tailor the topic to your needs.

The animals may include crocodiles, alligators, tortoises, snakes, lizards.

We are restricted to only visiting areas surrounding the zoo.

**Cost:** This is calculated depending on how many presentations are required, and distance we need to travel from Brize Norton.

### We are the perfect venue for group visits.

We host visits from groups as diverse as Vacation Care Centres, Seniors groups, Coach Tours, Scouts, Brownies, and Beavers, Pre-schools, Home School groups, Reptile Clubs and Societies.

These groups can benefit from a **10% discount** if booked in advance, and if the group size exceeds 20 people.

#### **After Hours visits:**

We are able to offer evening visits to Scouts, Beavers, Guides and Brownies, etc. These visits last 1.5 hours, and must be pre-booked.

8:00pm Monday to Friday **Cost:** Normal rates apply.

Note that there is a Minimum cost for After Hours visits of £150.
